Resident Spotlight: Peggy Moske

Legacy Place has had the pleasure of providing care for Peggy Moske since September of 2020.

Born on March 21, 1938, in Carbondale, Illinois, Peggy is the oldest child of George and Mary Brumley. When Peggy and her brother, Hank, were still very young, their parents' marriage dissolved, and they went to live with their grandparents, John and Myrtle Brumley. John and Myrtle had a daughter named Gladys. Myrtle and Gladys developed a deep, loving bond with Peggy. In many ways, Gladys became more like a sister to Peggy than an aunt.

Eventually, Peggy's father, George, remarried a pioneer sister named Lucille. They had three children: Judith, Philip, and Leslie. Even with 15 or more years between them, Peggy and Hank embraced their younger siblings and have an excellent relationship to this day.

Peggy dedicated her life to Jehovah and was baptized on September 2, 1951. On March 1, 1957, she entered full-time preaching work. Soon afterward, she fell in love with Paul Moske, and they were married on December 21, 1958. Together they entered special, full-time work on April 1, 1961. Paul and Peggy traveled for the next 50 years while he served as a circuit and district overseer. Their first assignments took them to North and South Dakota. By the time they retired from circuit work, they had served in 36 different states.

Even though Paul and Peggy were in their 70s when they left the circuit work, they continued to serve as special pioneers in Florida.

Paul passed away in 2013. During their 54 years of marriage, the Moskes truly dedicated their lives to serving Jehovah and always gave him their very best!
